

3 Week TOEFL Camps

Session I: Dec. 11 – 31

Session II: Jan. 1 – 21

Session III: Jan. 22 – Feb 11

IMPORTANT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION (students registering for TOEFL camps who do not meet these requirements will be moved into the ESL camps):

- Ages 16 and above **ONLY**
- Intermediate or Advanced level of English needed
- Best for students in the equivalent of their last two years of high school
- Extremely academic program – lots of reading and writing
- Morning sports program only - no skipping of class sessions to attend afternoon sports matches permitted

What is the difference between the 3 week ESL camps and the TOEFL camps?

Although the ESL camps and the TOEFL camps run at the same time, there are distinct differences. The TOEFL courses are for serious students of English who wish to concentrate on preparing for a specific exam, often needing a particular score for their chosen university. The ESL courses feature fun, interactive English activities. Emphasis is on communicative English, not on academic preparation.

What is the curriculum like?

At least 3 complete practice TOEFL tests will be given during the course. All work and practice tests will be reviewed with the students. Students will focus on academic listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

What is the TOEFL exam?

The TOEFL test measures the ability to use and understand English at the university level. More than 8,000 colleges, agencies and other institutions in over 130 countries accept TOEFL scores. Other organizations rely on TOEFL scores as well, including immigration departments and licensing agencies.

The TOEFL test has more test dates (30–40) and locations (**4,500 test centers in 165 countries**) than any other English-language test in the world. You can retake the test as many times as you wish.

Where do students take the TOEFL test?

International visitors often take the TOEFL either in Tampa or Sarasota (depending on availability). Dates during the camp sessions have not yet been released. If there is a test date available during the camp session, students can arrange transportation to take the test. At this moment we are not guaranteeing test availability. The TOEFL exam is easily taken in most students' home countries.

Who takes the TOEFL test?

Each year, nearly a million individuals of all ages take the TOEFL test to demonstrate their English-language proficiency. The average English skill level ranges between Intermediate and Advanced.
